The Arms Trade and Letter-Writing - October 13, 2014

Attended by about 22 people, this highly informative and interactive presentation began with a short video about one of the annual Arms Bazaars that takes place in Amman, Jordan. (See video [here](#)).

Following the video, Bev DeLong spoke about the global arms trade, giving statistics garnered from U.N. reports and others about the top manufacturers and exporters of arms, noting that Canada is the 15th largest arms exporter in the world. She also shared information regarding Canadian pension plans and urged the audience to contact their pension funds and investment advisors to ask that their money not be invested in arms production. The evening ended with a letter-writing session, which ranged from encouraging people to write Minister of Foreign Affairs John Baird, asking him to ratify the Arms Trade Treaty - to writing to your pension plan and banks to inquire about whether or not your

money is being used to invest in and promote the arms trade in any way - to writing to your pension plan to urge them to adopt ethical guidelines like those in Norway and New Zealand.





An evening of music and discussion with Former Prime Minister, The Right Honourable Joe Clark.


Friday, November 21, 2014 - 7:00pm


